Voting Information for Iowa Citizens

General Voting Information (U.S. & Iowa)

• Register to Vote:

Visit, https://sos.iowa.gov/elections/voterinformation/ to check your registration, update your address, or register online.

You must be registered 15 days before Election Day to vote in Iowa.

• Election Day Voting:

Polls in Iowa are typically open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

• Absentee / Early Voting:

You can vote early by mail or in person. The request deadline for an absentee ballot is usually **15 days before** the election. Find full details at https://sos.iowa.gov/elections/electioninfo/absenteeinfo.html

• Valid ID Required:

Iowa law requires a valid form of ID to vote in person. Examples include an Iowa driver's license, non-operator ID, U.S. passport, military ID, or voter ID card issued by your county auditor.

Your Local Districts: Winneshiek County

• U.S. House of Representatives (Congressional District 2):

You are represented at the federal level in the **2nd Congressional District of Iowa**. This includes much of eastern Iowa. Check <u>congress.gov</u> or your local election office for current candidate information.

• Iowa Senate – District 32:

Your Iowa State Senator represents District 32, responsible for drafting and voting on state laws that affect education, healthcare, agriculture, and more.

• Iowa House of Representatives – District 63:

Your local Iowa House member from District 63 speaks for your community in the Iowa House, focusing on local legislation and budget decisions.
